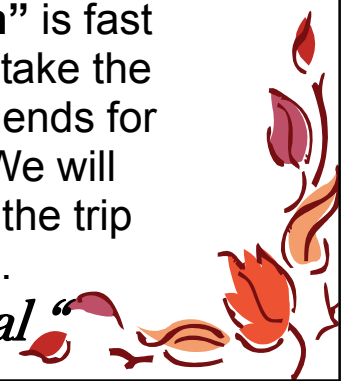

The Good, The Bad & The Ugly: Ethanol in Gasoline

We have all noticed the label at the gas pumps that alert us that gasoline may contain up to 10% Ethanol. Just what does this mean and how does it affect the car you are driving?

Ethanol is a type of alcohol that is produced primarily from corn in this country. Other countries may use other sources like sugar cane or sugar beets.

Ethanol has been mandated by the Federal Government to be added to gasoline to reduce the consumption of gasoline in vehicles. This concept is not new. Henry Ford designed the "Model T" to run on gasoline, ethanol or a combination of the two.

Ethanol DOES NOT provide the same amount of energy that gasoline does. Ethanol contains 2/3 of the energy per volume as gasoline.

Ethanol is an excellent solvent. It will dissolve paper gaskets and iron components of the fuel system in cars that are not designed to run ethanol in the fuel. Ethanol also dries out the rubber fuel lines and gaskets in vehicles.

Ethanol will also cause the fuel injectors in some cars to become clogged up to the point that cleaning is necessary and in some extreme cases, they will have to be replaced.

I believe that once again, the government has passed a mandate to the consumers in this country that has caused economic impact, not necessarily in a good way.
